Landfill-bound paper (28.7%) and food waste (41.4%) are two of our biggest waste areas. We will take steps to address these next season.
	Energy Efficiency	Galena, Wizard, and Chuter lift drive upgrades.	Upgrading old lift drives increased efficiency on these chairlifts, reducing energy used by thousands of kWh.
	Greenhouse Gas monitoring	We are tracking Scope 1 and 2 GHG emissions and will treat this year as a 'baseline' to inform future reduction measures.	The need to measure fuel used for main lodge heating became clear; we will add that as a project for next season.
