Guest and Employee Engagement	Naturalist tours, Green Team, and the compost and carpool programs are all ways that employees can engage with our sustainability efforts	53+ guests attended a tour; 39 employees were involved with Green Team, 29 logged carpools, and 13 took compost soil
Transportation Efficiency	Employee carpool program	Over 6.5 tons of GHG emissions & 14,700 miles avoided, according to logged employee carpools
Waste Reduction	Reusable dishware, employee reusables, composting, and old uniform donation	600+ jackets donated, landfill paper down to 15% of Main Lodge waste on average (from 29% in 22-23) with reusables, 1,020+ lbs food waste diverted from landfill
